Engagement Activities

The below opportunities are frequent offerings with Habitat DC-NOVA, and we'd be love to discuss creatively any additional interests your group has for a volunteer activity!

<u>Build Days</u>: Build days with Habitat DC-NOVA are a full day experience (8:30-3:30 with a lunch break) where groups help us directly construct Habitat homes. No previous experience or skills are necessary - our team of site supervisors will provide training and supervision for the duration of the construction activity, ranging from framing, installing insulation, cutting trim, painting, and more. For the remainder of 2024, build days will be available at a full home rehabilitation in Capitol Hill, DC. This site can take one group of up to 10 volunteers per week. Additional build days will become available in the 2025 in Deanwood, DC and Fairfax, VA as we open new sites.

ReStore Days: Our ReStores in Chantilly, Alexandria, and Herndon accept volunteers all year long. Volunteer crews typically participate in shifts of 2-3 hours and complete activities such as pricing, organizing inventory, unloading donation trucks, and assisting customers. As part of the ReStore experience, Habitat staff also provide an in-depth presentation (often a 'lunch and learn') to attending employee volunteers to learn about the work the ReStore supports and Habitat's programs.

<u>Playhouse Builds</u>: Volunteers work together to build and paint a playhouse that is then either donated to a Habitat family, donated to a child care partner, or auctioned through the ReStore to support a build project. In addition to playhouse, we also work with volunteers to construct items including adirondack chairs, picnic tables, and bookshelves for homeowner families. Playhouse and other item builds can take up to 10 volunteers for a full day and are hosted at our Alexandria ReStore.

<u>Neighborhood Revitalization Days:</u> This pilot program takes volunteer crews into partnering neighborhoods to provide yardwork, painting, exterior repairs, and weatherization for low-income residents. NR days can take up to 10 volunteers for a full or half day and also includes a presentation for employee volunteers to learn about the impact of the work and community needs.

<u>Family Welcome Basket Assembly:</u> Volunteers come together either on a Habitat site or at their own offices/preferred site to assemble baskets for new Habitat homeowners, such as welcome baskets with new home essentials, tools, and financial planning tools.
